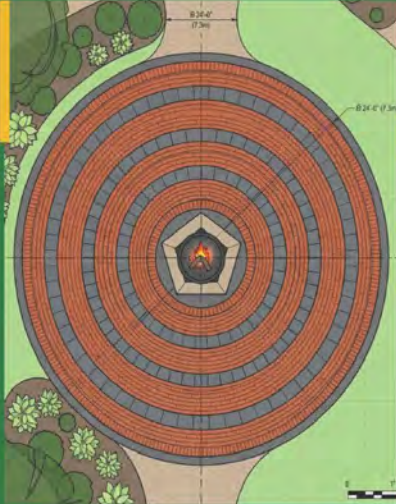

 Branch recognition structures with flagpoles representing each military branch placed outside the perimeter, with seating, landscaping, and dedication elements.

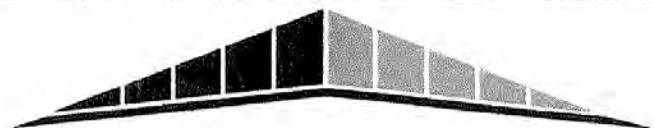
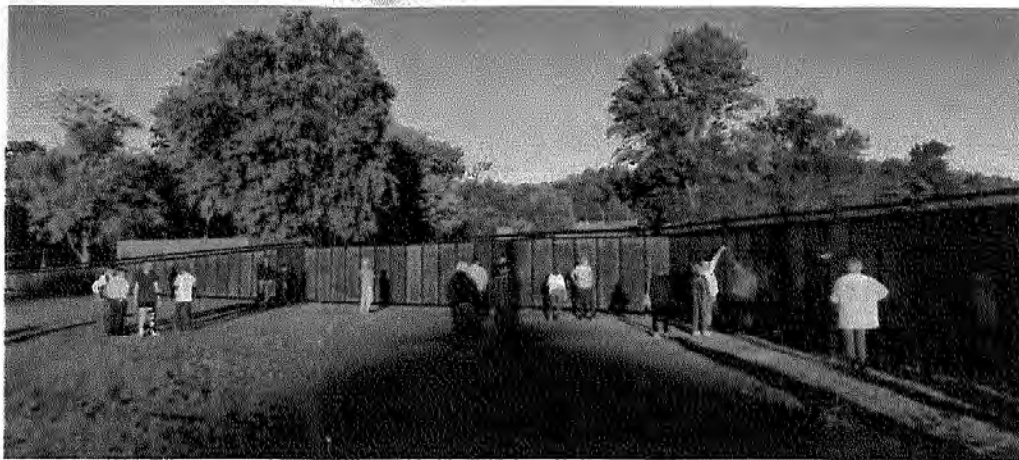
